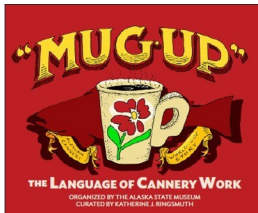
Preservation Alaska reveals its 2022 Ten Most Endangered Historic Properties list as the kick off for National Historic Preservation Month.

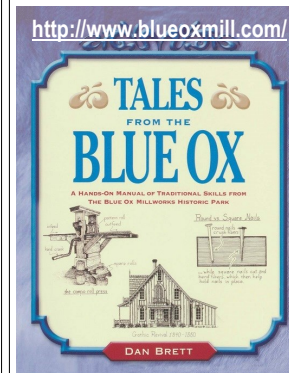
